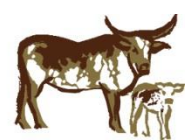
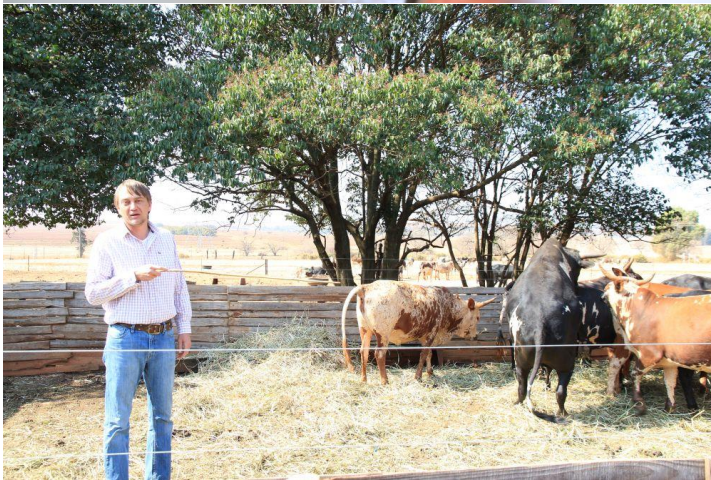

NNK CLUB AUCTION: 2 NOVEMBER 2013, KLEIN KARIBA

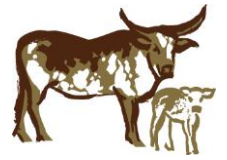
