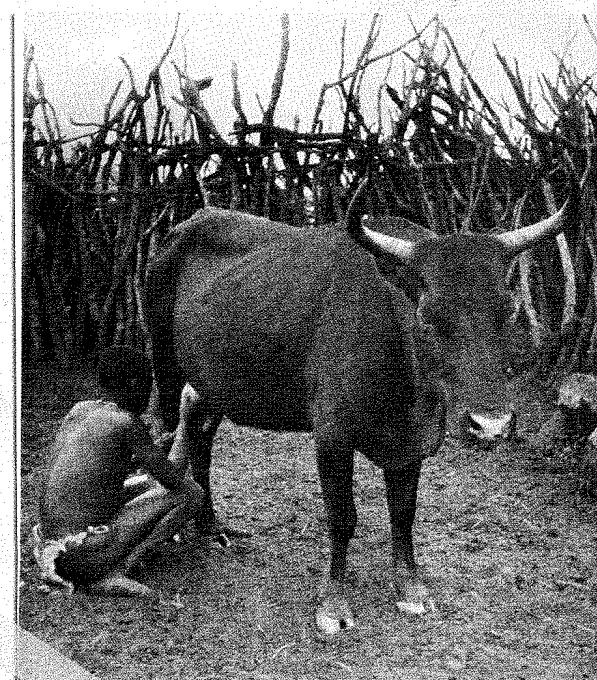
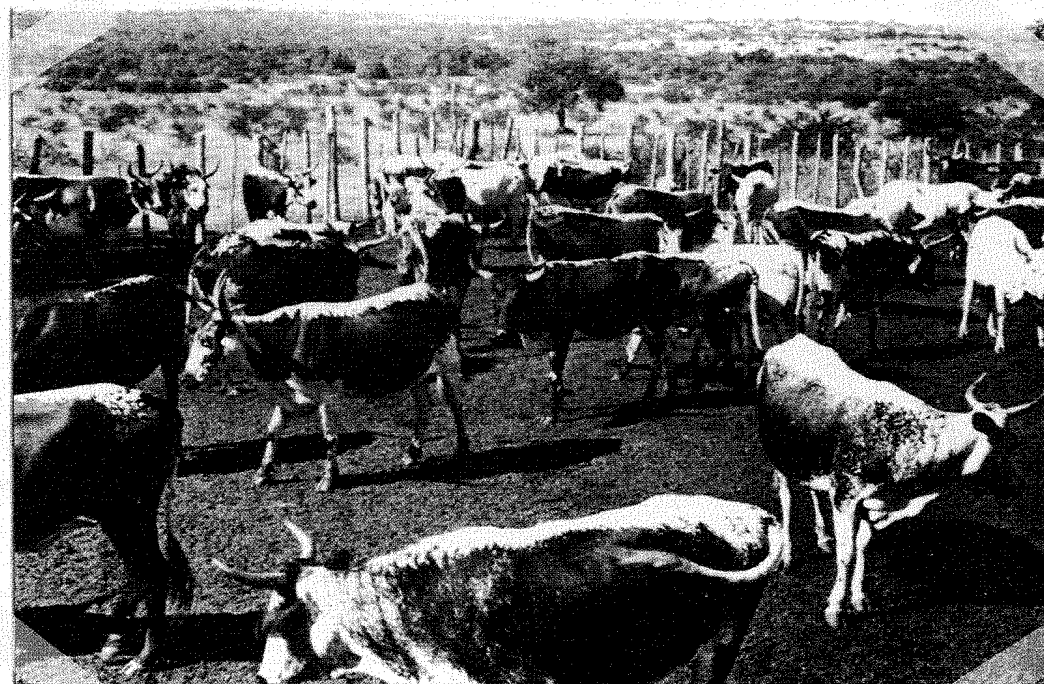


Of the first 100 members who joined the Society from 1984-1988, 11 still remain as active members, although some have had name-changes.

## *Clubs:*

From the outset the value of Nguni clubs, to encourage participation within the breed and also to assist with inspections, was realized. Initially, in 1987, the Central Club, covering Natal, Free State and Eastern Cape, and the Transvaal Club covering the Transvaal and Northern Transvaal were formed.

Out of these the present clubs were eventually formed so that the Nguni Society now has 7 clubs covering the greater South Africa, namely Northern, Natal, Central, Karoo, Eastern Cape, Highveld and Kalahari. The present Central club was formed in 1995, covering mainly the Free State, and the Natal Club came into being on its own.
